Contract Title: Civil works for rehabilitation of road Agarak-Yahdan-Koghes-Mghart-Arevatsag-Karmir Aghek-Tsater-Aygehat-Ardvi-Odzun-M6, Road Sections H35-Ardvi km0+000-km2+571 and H33-Mghart km0+000-km0+907

1. The Republic of Armenia has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the *Lifeline Roads Network Improvement Project*, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Civil works for rehabilitation of road Agarak-Yahdan-Koghes-Mghart-Arevatsag-Karmir Aghek-Tsater-Aygehat-Ardvi-Odzun-M6, Road Sections H35-Ardvi km0+000-km2+571 and H33-Mghart km0+000-km0+907. These contracts will be jointly financed by World Bank and the Government of the Republic of Armenia. Bidding process will be governed by the World Bank's rules and procedures.

2. The The Transport Projects Implementation Unit State Institution of Ministry of Transport and Communication of the Republic of Armenia now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Contract CW-NCB-LRNIP -2015/6 Civil works for rehabilitation of road Agarak-Yahdan-Koghes-Mghart-Arevatsag-Karmir Aghek-Tsater-Aygehat-Ardvi-Odzun-M6, Road Sections H35-Ardvi km0+000-km2+571 and H33-Mghart km0+000-km0+907 (Armenia, Lori Marz). The works consist of *removal of old sub base and construction of new sub base, crushed stone base, asphalt layer, pothole patching, Construction of stabilized gravel pavement with Portland cement, placing of leveling blanket, asphalt concrete overlay, drainage, road safety measures, et..* The rehabilitation should be completed by November 30, 2016.

Bidding Documents require bidders to have the following specific experience

- (i) A minimum number of similar contracts specified below that have been satisfactorily and substantially completed as a prime contractor, joint venture member management contractor or sub-contractor between 1st January 2010 year and application submission deadline: One contract with minimum value AMD209 000 000 (or USD 435,000 equivalent) or 2 contracts, each of minimum value AMD104 500 000 (or USD 217,500 equivalent). The similarity shall be based on the physical size, complexity, methods/technology.
- (ii) A minimum experience in the following key activities:
 - EARTH WORKS: min 5,700 m³ in any year within the last five years
 - PAVEMENT WORKS: min 12,900 m² in any year within the last five years
 - DRAINAGE WORKS: min 995 l.m. in any year within the last five years

3. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's [*Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers*](#) published on January 2011 ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in

the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

4. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the address below on 15:01 (Yerevan time) on 14 April, 2015.
