1. The **Republic of Armenia** has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of **2860-ARM: Water Supply and Sanitation Sector Project-Additional Financing**. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the contract named above. This contract will be jointly financed by the Armenian Government. Bidding is open to all bidders from eligible source countries of the ADB.
2. The Armenian Water and Sewerage CJSC ("the Employer") invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the construction and completion of **L2860-ICB-1-05/3, Improvement WSS in Dilijan town and Bagratashen, Pthavan, Zorakan villages**

The Works consists of:

**Dilijan town**

- Construction of 0.6km length Spitakajur river drainage system with de315-de225 PE corrugated pipes.

**Bagratashen village**

- Rehabilitation of different sections of 2.1km length, DN200, DN150 St water main in the external system,
- Rehabilitation of 400m<sup>3</sup> capacity DRR by reconstruction of technological units and pipes,
- Construction of 8.5 km length, de200-de40 PE waterline,
- Construction of 5.1km length, de32-de20 PE inlet lines for private houses with installation of 651 water meter chambers.

**Ptghavan village**

- Rehabilitation of 0.5km length, DN100 St water main in the external system,
- Rehabilitation of 160m<sup>3</sup> capacity DRR by reconstruction of technological units and pipes,
- Construction of 5.5km length, de160-de50 PE waterlines,
- Construction of 1.6km length, de32-de20 PE inlet lines for private houses with installation of 187 water meter chambers.

**Zorakan village**

- Construction of new 6.4x3.8m, H=3.7m pumping station with installation of two Q=9.5l/sec, H=150m pipes,
- Construction of 40m<sup>3</sup> water intake reservoir with reconstruction of technological units and pipes,
- Construction of 1.1km length, de110 PE waterlines.

3. International competitive bidding will be conducted in accordance with ADB's **"Single-Stage: One-Envelope" bidding procedure** and is open to all Bidders from eligible source countries.
4. Only eligible bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:

-Minimum average annual construction turnover of **US\$ 1,890,000** (one million eight hundred eighty thousand US dollars) calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last 3 (three) years.

-Access to or availability of financial resources such as liquid assets, unencumbered real assets, lines of credit and other financial means, other than any contractual advance payments for the amount **US\$ 270,000** (two hundred seventy thousand US dollars).

-Participation as contractor, management contractor, or subcontractor, in at least 1 (one) contract within the last 3 (three) years, each with a value of at least **US\$ 800,000** (eight hundred thousand US dollars) that has been successfully or is substantially completed and that is similar to the proposed works. The similarity shall be construction of **10km of PE Pipelines**.

-All pending litigation shall be treated as resolved against the Bidder and so shall in total not represent more than 50 percent of the Bidder's net worth.

**The Bidder shall hold a valid and effective license/permit for hydro-technical facilities, issued by the RA Urban Development Ministry. In case of the absence of this license/permit the Bidders shall submit with the bid a signed statement that if the bidder is awarded the Contract he will obtain the required license from the RA Urban Development Ministry.**
