- The Republic of Armenia has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost
 of 2860-ARM: Water Supply and Sanitation Sector Project-Additional Financing. Part of this financing
 will be used for payments under the contract named above. This contract will be jointly financed by the
 Armenian Government. Bidding is open to all bidders from eligible source countries of the ADB.
- The Armenian Water and Sewerage CJSC ("the Employer") invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the construction and completion of L2860-ICB-1-03/2, Improvement of Water Supply Systems in Tsaghkadzor town and Akunk village

The Works consists of:

Tsaghkadzor town:

External system

- Replacement of 2 vertical pumping units in Makravan-2 pumping station of Tsaghkadzor town,
- Construction of DN500 diameter, 358.0m length steel gravity water main from water intake of Makravan-3 pumping station to Makravan-2 pumping station.
- Construction of water main from Makravan-2 pumping station to the "Writers House" DRR with 2 sections. Section 1 of the water main: construction of 1.6km, DN273x6 steel pipeline. Section II of the water main: construction of 1.6km, de280 PE pipeline.
- Construction of new 1000m3 capacity DRR.

Distribution network

- Construction of de225-de110, 2.6km PE internal waterline,
- Construction of 300.0m, de32-de20 PE inlet lines for private houses and business entities with installation of 30 water meter chambers.

Akunq village:

- Construction of internal 9.2km length, de160-de63 PE pipelene,
- Construction of 3.1km, de32-de20 PE inlet lines for 460 private houses with installation of plastic water meter chambers,
- Rehablitation of Akunq village pumping station by replacing technological units.
- 3. International competitive bidding will be conducted in accordance with ADB's "Single-Stage: One-Envelope" bidding procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible source countries.
- 4. Only eligible bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:

- -Minimum average annual construction turnover of US\$ 2,400,000 (Two million four hundred thousand US dollars) calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last 3 (three) years.
- Access to or availability of financial resources such as liquid assets, unencumbered real assets, lines of credit and other financial means, other than any contractual advance payments for the amount US\$ 640,000 (six hundred forty thousand US dollars).
- -Participation as contractor, management contractor, or subcontractor, in at least 1 (one) contract within the last 3 (three) years, each with a value of at least US\$ 1,280,000 (one million two hundred eighty thousand US dollars) that has been successfully or is substantially completed and that is similar to the proposed works. The similarity shall be construction of 10km of PE Pipelines.
- -All pending litigation shall be treated as resolved against the Bidder and so shall in total not represent more than 50 percent of the Bidder's net worth.

The Bidder shall hold a valid and effective license/permit for hydro-technical facilities, issued by the RA Urban Development Ministry. In case of the absence of this license/permit the Bidders shall submit with the bid a signed statement that if the bidder is awarded the Contract he will obtain the required license from the RA Urban Development Ministry.
